

Privacy Policy

FableVision Inc. (FableVision), owner and developer of Get A Clue® software and the Internet Web site www.getaclue.com, is committed to assuring the privacy of its subscribers and users. The purpose of this privacy policy is to describe how FableVision collects, protects, and uses personal information on its Internet Web site www.getaclue.com.

This Privacy Policy can be reviewed from any screen that requests personal information from subscribers and users.

Registration

All subscribers must register before using GetAClue services. During registration, subscribers are required to give limited personal information, as described below. FableVision treats student information with the highest level of protection.

- **Administrators** - Each subscriber school will designate one person to be its Get A Clue administrator, or School Coordinator. The School Coordinator's initial login requires his or her first and last name.
- **Teachers** - During teachers' initial login to the program, they are asked to confirm their first and last names.
- **Students** - During students' initial login to the program, only information previously approved by an authorized school or district official is collected. This information, collected for the purpose of reporting results to authorized school officials, may contain one or more of the following: first name, last name, student ID, or other selected fields determined by an authorized school or district official. Upon initial login, students enter this approved information and then personalize their accounts by selecting unique usernames and passwords. The username and approved identifying information will appear to the individual students as they use Get A Clue and to authorized teachers and administrators from the

school as they use the program.

Student participation in Get A Clue is not conditioned upon providing personal identification information to FableVision. A student who chooses not to enter the school-approved information still can gain access to the program. The program will generate a user ID (Ex. Student 5469 GHS), and the student will personalize his or her account by selecting a unique username and password. It is then this user's responsibility to identify him- or her-self to the appropriate teachers (for scoring purposes) as being associated to this user identification.

Access to Services

- **Administrators** - Administrators access Get A Clue School Coordinator accounts by logging in with a valid username and password obtained from their Get A Clue distributor. Upon their initial login, they will personalize their account by selecting a unique username and password, which they will use for each subsequent use of Get A Clue. If administrators forget their username or password, they will need to call Tech Support. Tech Support will authenticate the School Coordinator using a series of questions designed to ensure positive identification prior to retrieving the username or resetting the password of the School Coordinator.

After successfully logging in, administrators will enter their school's teacher and class names, then obtain automatically generated First-Time Login Coupons for their teachers.

- **Teachers** - Teachers access Get A Clue by logging in with a valid username and password, obtained from their administrator, or designated School Coordinator. Upon their initial login, they will personalize their account by selecting a unique username and password, which they will use for each subsequent use of Get A Clue. They

then will verify that the School Coordinator has listed their appropriate classes correctly. If teachers forget their username or password, they will need to contact their School Coordinator who can update this information for them.

After successfully logging in, teachers will generate First-Time Login Coupons that they then can distribute to their students.

- **Students** - Students access Get A Clue by logging in with a valid username and password obtained from their teacher. Upon their first login, students then select unique usernames and passwords, which they will use for each subsequent use of Get A Clue. If students forget their username or password, they will need to contact their teacher who can update this information for them.
- **Parents/Guardians** - A parent may wish to view a child's progress or help him or her review for quizzes. To do this, parents can login to Get A Clue by using their child's specific username and password. A teacher also may help parents review with their children by generating printed reports of the student's progress.

Changing Information

Administrators and teachers can change their personal account information (i.e., name, username, password, optional e-mail address) at any time using their Get A Clue accounts. If students (or parents of these students) would like to change any of their personal account information, they need to contact their teacher who can update this information for them.

A school or district may contact FableVision, and/or the Get A Clue customer support team, directly if it would like all data, including School Coordinator and Teacher accounts, to be deleted from the Get A Clue system.

Registered schools may delete both student and teacher

account information and data with the School Coordinator account. Students (or parents of these students) or teachers who desire all information associated with their account to be deleted should contact their administrator.

Use of Information

FableVision and/or its proprietary companies collects information gathered as subscribing users register for and progress through the Get A Clue program strictly for the purposes of academic research, product development, and data maintenance. Furthermore, no user information will be used for solicitation purposes or released to a member of the public without appropriate prior consent.

Only registered administrators and teachers have access to reports of student progress containing user identification. Internal reports that authorized employees of FableVision and its affiliates may access do not associate records of student progress with the real names of students. Parents who wish to access reports of their child's progress should contact their child's teacher(s). Finally, FableVision may disclose student information that is considered necessary to protecting student safety or deemed necessary by a governmental agency for the purpose of enforcing any law or regulation.

The information gathered from Free Trial users is used strictly for the purposes of academic research, product development, and product marketing. Any statistics based upon the Free Trial subscription information and referenced by FableVision or its proprietary companies will be anonymous. (Users under the age of 13 may access the Free Trial without providing personal information.)

FableVision may generate and distribute demographic reports in summary form, including reports on patterns of usage. In such cases, FableVision will not reveal the identity of any user.

FableVision also will take the most appropriate commercially reasonable measures to obtain written consent from its users if it starts using the information collected from its users in a manner different from that stated at the time of collection.
